COVID-19 Guidelines for the 2023-24 School Year

All Sant Bani School COVID-19 guidelines have been written with guidance from the CDC and the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). Please note that the School's COVID-19 guidelines could change during the school year if community spread levels in the region increase or if a more virulent strain develops - especially in the winter as the colder weather will result in more time spent indoors. We will promptly share any changes that occur with parents.

When to Remain at Home

If a student is diagnosed with COVID-19, the family should immediately email nurse@santbani.org and the student must remain at home for 5 days from the onset of their symptoms. They may return at the end of the 5-day period if symptoms have resolved and they have been **fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication**.

Testing

Sant Bani School strongly recommends that students who develop symptoms are tested. We also recommend that, if a household member tests positive, students test 3-5 days after the household member's positive test date.

Masking

Masking is optional unless a student is returning to school following a positive COVID test, per-CDC guidelines. CDC guidelines state that, in this instance, individuals must wear a mask indoors, and while in close proximity around others outdoors, through Day 10 (following notification of a positive test, the school nurse will share Day 5 - final day of required isolation - and Day 10 with the family).
